

Fourth and Fifth Confirmed Cases of HKIEd Human Swine Influenza (Influenza A, H1N1) Virus Infection

To all Staff & Students,

A student residing in the JCSQ and a child who attended a Project Aspire Training Programme were reported on 25 and 29 July 2009 respectively to have been infected with the Human Swine Influenza (Influenza A, H1N1) virus and were now recovering from the sickness. Disinfectant cleaning of the concerned JCSQ unit and classroom, the Student Union office and the Project Aspire office were subsequently conducted.

Staff and students are again reminded to be vigilant in observing flu-like symptoms. Those who experience any flu-like symptoms are requested to wear masks while inside the Institute campus areas, and to seek urgent medical attention in case any of the following symptoms has developed:-

- Has difficulty in breathing or chest pain
- Has purple or blue discoloration of the lips
- Is vomiting and unable to swallow liquids
- Has signs of dehydration such as dizziness when standing, absence of urination
- Has seizures
- Is less responsive than normal or becomes confused.

Those with signs of fever should stay home and seek medical attention as deemed necessary instead of coming to campus.
