Message No. 4 to All Staff and Students on Influenza A (H1N1) on 8 June 2009 Examination Period

Dear Staff and Students,

To prevent the spread of Influenza A, H1N1 during the examination periods, all students are requested to check their temperature at home before attending the examination. As a matter of good personal hygiene, all staff are also encouraged to check their temperature before going to work. Anyone having a temperature exceeding 37.5 degrees Celsius is advised to stay home and to seek medical advice. Any student who needs to stay home because of fever should apply to the relevant Head of Department through the module lecturer together with relevant documentary evidence such as a medical certificate for alternative examination arrangements.

Those who are unable to comply with the above hygiene measures due to the absence of a thermometer at home are advised to go to the Security Control Centre for checking their temperature. The security staff there will be ready to take their temperature by using a forehead scanning typed infrared thermometer. For students residing on campus, they can go to the respective Hall Management Office for temperature checking. A forehead scanning typed infrared thermometer will be used to help students taking their temperature.
